
App 4 Independence Research Study



Participate in a series of 3 service provider focus groups exploring how an app for individuals who experience opioid use disorder could be helpful.

The smart phone app is designed to:

- Connect people with addictions with their care providers
- Facilitate peer-peer support
- Provide evidence-informed strategies and tools



The focus group is for people who:

- Are 18 years old or over
- Read and speak conversational English
- Are currently in a professional role providing support to individuals with opioid use disorder, such as a nurse, psychiatrist, social worker, addictions specialist, peer support, etc.



Focus groups will take place either in person at a CAMH downtown site or virtually on the Webex platform. Participants will be reimbursed.
